

# Angel of Kindness

## Materials required

Oddments of Dk yarn,  
Knitting needles, two 3.25mm / US size 2.5  
Polyester toy filler, small amount to stuff the head  
Tapestry needle to sew up.

## Angel Body

Starting at top of head. Cast on 6 stitches  
Row 1. Knit into front and back of each stitch (12 sts).  
Row 2. Purl  
Row 3. (K1, make1, K1) repeat to end  
Make 1 by picking up loop between stitches, knit into the back of it.  
Row 4. Purl  
Row 5. (K1, make1, K2) repeat to end  
Row 6. Purl  
Row 7. Knit  
Row 8. Purl  
Row 9. (K1, K2tog, K1) repeat to end  
Row 10. Purl  
Row 11. (K1, K2tog) repeat to end  
Row 12. Purl  
\*If using more than once colour change to body colour here.  
Row 13. Knit into front and back of each stitch (24sts).  
Row 14. Purl  
Row 15. Knit  
Row 16. Purl  
Row 17. Knit  
Row 18. Purl  
Row 19. ( K1, yarn over needle, K1) repeat to end  
Row 20. Purl  
Row 21. Knit  
Row 22. Purl  
Row 23. Knit  
Row 24. Purl  
Row 25. Knit  
Row 26. Purl  
Row 27. (K3, Yarn over needle) repeat to last 3 stitches, K3.  
Row 28. Purl  
Row 29. Knit  
Row 30. Knit  
Row 31. Purl  
Row 32. Knit  
Cast off purlwise

To make up turn inside out and sew up seam along back of body. Turn right side out and stuff head. Using an embroidery needle sew a row of gathering stitches at neck and pull tight.



## Angel Arms

(Knit a 'tube' or 'i-cord', 4 stitches wide, 21 rows long).

Cast on 4 stitches

Knit 21 rows using the following method if you don't have double pointed needles,

Knit 4 stitches

Slip all stitches back onto the left needle

Knit 4 stitches

Slip all stitches back onto the left needle.

Repeat until 21 rows have been knitted

Cast off

Make one long arm and when sewing up stitch the centre of the i-cord to the centre of the body to form hands. Sew either end of the cord to the back of the dress to form shoulders.

## Wings

Cast on 9 stitches

Row 1. K8, wrap yarn around next stitch and turn,

Row 2. Knit 8

Row 3. K6, wrap yarn around next stitch and turn,

Row 4. Knit 6

Row 5. Knit 4, wrap yarn around next stitch and turn,

Row 6. Knit 4

Row 7. Knit 2, wrap yarn around next stitch and turn,

Row 8. Knit 2

Row 9. Knit 4, wrap yarn around next stitch and turn,

Row 10. Knit 4

Row 11. K6, wrap yarn around next stitch and turn,

Row 12. Knit 6

Repeat last 12 rows to form wing shape (*6 or 7 times as desired to form the wing shape*)

To finish work, repeat Row 1 and row 2 once.

Cast off all 8 stitches knitwise.
