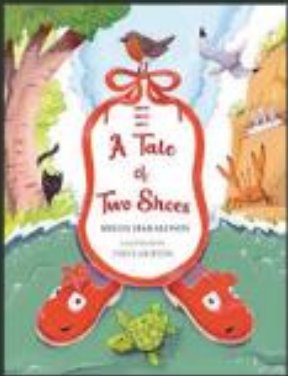

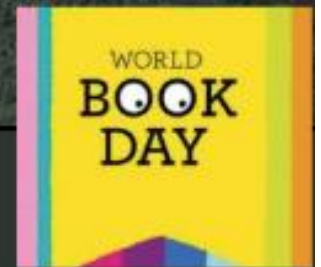
SHOES FOR SCHOOL
