Smart Watches in school:

We have a growing number of children coming to school wearing Smart Watches. Please can we ask that these watches be left at home. Firstly, there are 'online safety' issues with these watches and children's access to the internet whilst in school. Also, we know how much money these devices cost: we cannot guarantee that throughout the course of the day, a watch may be damaged or broken. Finally, these watches can cause a distraction to learning. If you would like your child to wear a watch for school in order to support their learning to tell the time, an 'old-fashioned' (and cheap) analogue watch is what is needed. Thank you for your support with this matter.
