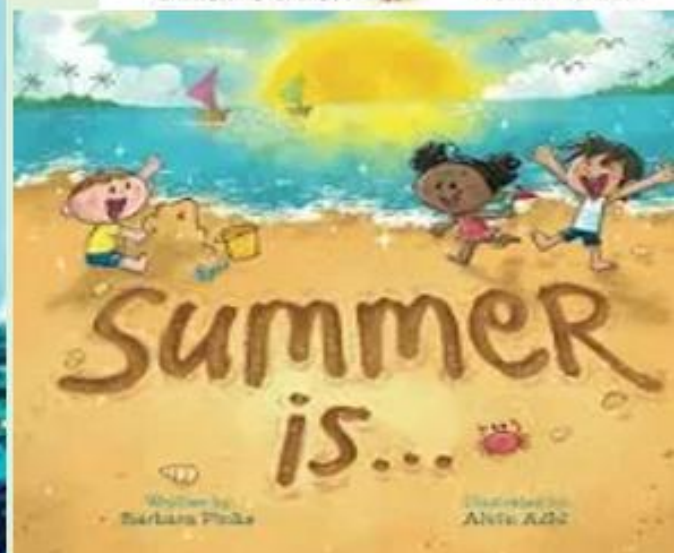
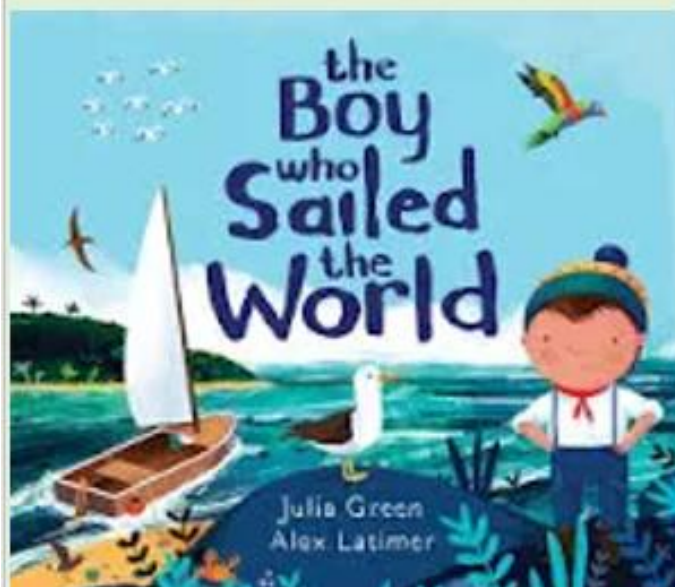


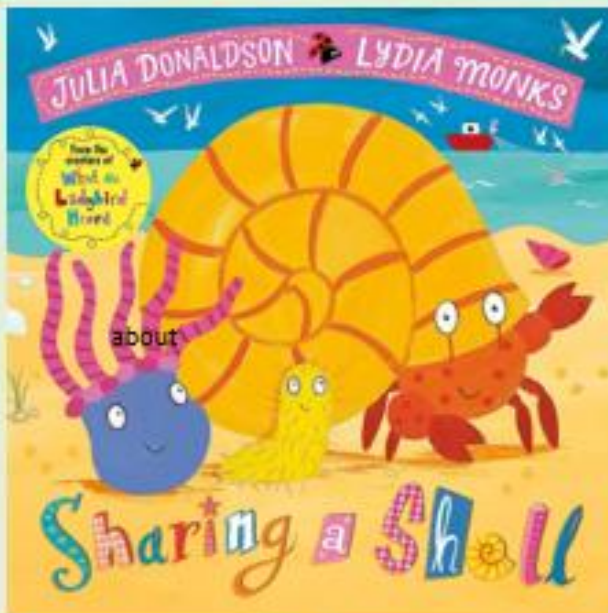
Summer Reading recommendations and reviews by the Year 6 Reading Ambassadors:

A fabulous book by James DuBern.

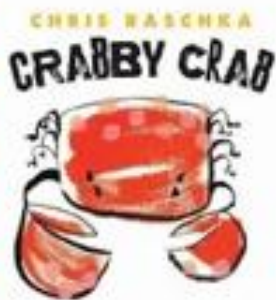
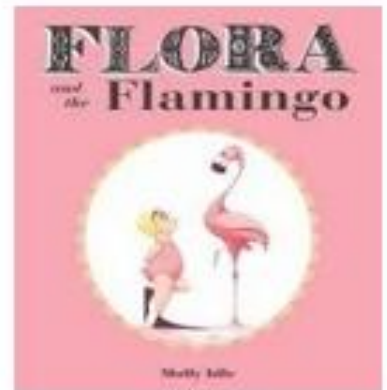


16 Summer Books For Kids



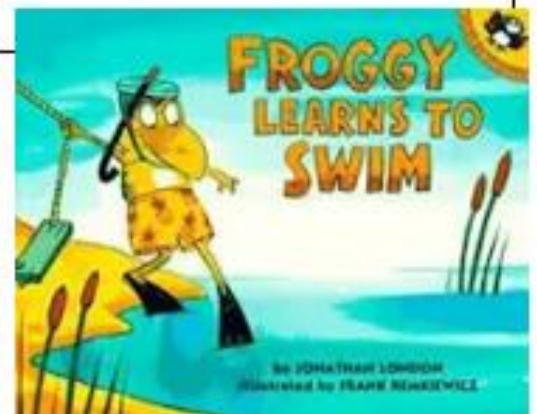
More REVIEWS
