## Important Attendance Information

Dear parents / carers

As we move through the final week of the academic year there is much to celebrate regarding attendance at our school. Together, we have achieved a collective attendance of **96.9%** which is 2.1% above the National average of 94.8% and the Local Authority average of 95.2%.

We have 94 pupils in school whose attendance is classed as 'good'; 53 pupils what have hit our target of 97% and we have **an incredible 9 pupils who have 100% attendance!** Many congratulations to all of our children and families.

Whilst these figures are excellent, and we are confident we can further increase the number of pupils who achieve our target next year, we have noticed an increase in unauthorised absences in the past half term. It is very important that all members of our school community continue to have high expectations for attendance going into our final days of this year and when we enter the 2025-26 academic year.

With the rise in unauthorised absence and term-time holidays, it is really important that we remind you of our duty as a school to refer all holiday absences to the Local Authority which result in fines being issued, but also of our duty to refer cases where 10 sessions (5 school days) are unauthorised across a rolling 10 week period. These cases also result in fines being issued by the Local Authority. We do not want any of our families to be faced with paying one of these, therefore we ask for your support in ensuring your children attend school every day this week.

To avoid any potential issue for families, we feel it is vital that we make the Local Authority process clear to you all. Should a term-time holiday occur, the first fixed penalty notice (FPN) is £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days. If a second holiday absence occurs (this does not have to occur in the same academic year) then the FPN increases to £160 per parent, per child. A third occurrence would result in prosecution.

We thank you for your support in maintaining excellent attendance and for your understanding in us needing to make the Local Authority's procedures clear.

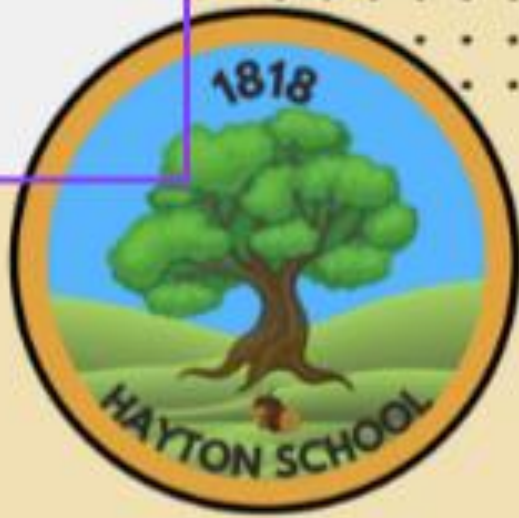
