Parking Issues in the village at pick-up time and the guidance:

Can I park on double yellow lines?

The [Highway Code](#) explains that double yellow lines “indicate a prohibition of waiting at any time even if there are no upright signs.”

When it comes to double yellow lines, the best bet is to assume that you can't park there at any time.

There are some exceptions.

- ⇒ You might be allowed to quickly stop to load or unload heavy goods.
- ⇒ If you're a [Blue Badge carrier](#), you can usually park on both double and single yellow lines for up to 3 hours, providing you have your badge clearly on display.

These exceptions won't always apply though, so check for local signs or kerb edge markings. If there are pairs of short yellow lines over the kerb edge you're not allowed to load at any time. Even with a Blue Badge you mustn't park anywhere where there are loading restrictions.

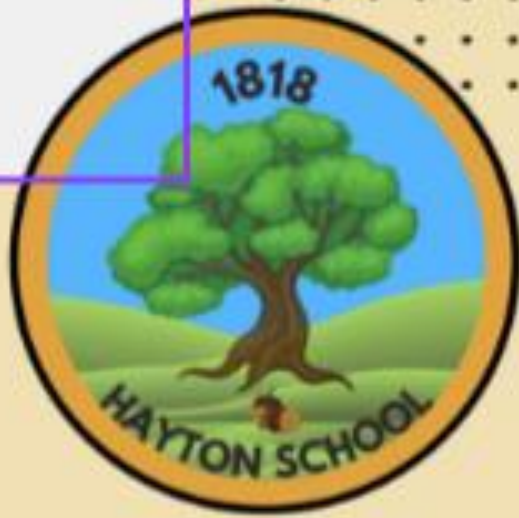

Can I park at the mouth of a junction?

No, you cannot park at the mouth of a junction; the Highway Code advises against it and specifies a 10-meter (32-foot) exclusion zone from a junction unless a marked parking bay is present. This rule is in place to ensure drivers have a clear view of the road, pedestrians, and other hazards, which is essential for safety when pulling out or turning into the junction.

Can I park where yellow cones have been placed?

No, you cannot park where yellow cones have been placed, as yellow cones are used by councils and contractors to indicate no-stopping, parking, or waiting areas, and unauthorized use can result in a fine. Yellow cones are a part of temporary traffic management to prevent vehicles from blocking traffic or accessing certain areas .
