Theatre Trips, Wednesday 10th December, R-Y6

As a Christmas treat, we are taking all the children in R-Y6 to a pantomime on Wednesday 10th December. Whilst the children are out, the Nursery children will have their annual Christmas party 9:30 – 12 to which all nursery children are invited even if it is not their normal day to attend nursery.

The children in Reception to Year 3 will go to Queens Hall, Hexham to see a performance of 'Red Riding Hood'.

The children in Years 4 to Year 6 will go to Theatre by the Lake to see a performance of 'The Wizard of Oz'.

Due to the need for prompt 9 am departures on coaches to make the performances, after registration, we will need all children in school by 8.40 am at the latest. They will return to school before the end of the school day.

Transport to and from the Queens Hall will be provided by Reays Coaches and to Theatre by The Lake transport will be provided by Metcalfe Coaches. We would like to take this opportunity to thank the PTA who have given school a considerable donation towards the transport costs. Without this contribution, we would not have been able to go.

Please can you send your child into school on the day with a snack, a packed lunch and a drink as the children will not be back at school in time for school lunches.

We ask for a contribution of £12 towards the cost of admission to the theatre. Please note that tickets are purchased in advance, so cancellations cannot be refunded. Please also be aware that, should insufficient contributions be forthcoming, the trips may not be viable.
