Impact

The Accelerated Reader programme purchased during 2012 – 2013 with pupil premium money and the increase in phonics books purchased this year has improved reading outcomes. Move4Words purchased during 2012 – 2013 has had a positive impact on Literacy and behaviour skills.

Year 1 – 2 pupils have progressed in line with their cohort.

Year 2 – 1 pupil has progressed in line with their cohort and 2 pupils are working above their cohort.

Year 3 – 3 pupils have progressed in line with their cohort.

Year 4 – 1 pupil has progressed in line with their cohort.

Year 5 – 3 pupils have progressed in line with their cohort and 1 pupil is working above their cohort.

Year 6 – 2 pupils have progressed in line with their cohort.
