- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

Parent/Carer

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19 I will not send them to school. We will self-isolate for 14 days, as a family. I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible the outcome via telephone.
- If my child, or another child in the 'bubble', shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2m (or 1m+ if this is not possible) social distancing rules, observing the routes marked out around the school site.
- It is vital that I arrive promptly for drop off and collection times to ensure the successful management of this arrangement with increased numbers in September.
- My child may bring their school reading folder into school and will be able to take items home from school (e.g. reading books and homework folders).
- I will provide my child with a warm and waterproof coat, sun hat, a re-sealable labelled drinks bottle and packed lunch if they are not having school dinners.
- My child will come into school wearing their PE kit on the day they have PE. In the winter black or blue tracksuit bottoms will be required.
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene (catch it, bin it, kill it!).
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I must read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

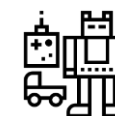
I will do my best to:

Wash my hands for 20 seconds.

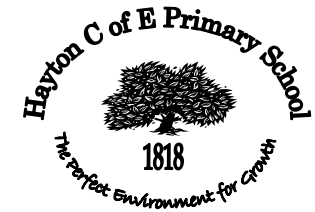
