Parking

Sadly, we have been notified by residents of our community about parents regularly parking on the double yellow lines at the T junction and causing blockages to peoples' driveways. This is happening at morning and end of day drop off times. Parking has always been an issue in Hayton as it is a small village, but it doesn't help if adults are not respectful of the rules. The double yellow lines have been placed there for a reason. The Highway Code states that double yellow lines "indicate a prohibition of waiting at any time". These residents have now threatened that they will call the police. Therefore, I am asking everyone to please PARK RESPECTFULLY at all times.

The road from the A69 at Edmond Castle turn off to Castle View will be closed for one day on 14th October 2021.

Covid-19 – Public Health Latest Guidelines Reminder

- **Children and young people aged between 5 and 16 are now advised to stay at home (unless exempt – see below) when a sibling tests positive for COVID-19 via either a PCR or Lateral Flow test.**
- 3-5 days after the onset of symptoms in the sibling who has tested positive (or test date if the positive case had no symptoms), the close contact child should get a PCR test.
- If negative, they can return to school, but should isolate immediately and get another test if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 later.
- The groups exempt from this advice are:
 - 12–18-year-olds who have had at least one dose of the vaccine more than 14 days ago
 - Any child aged between 5 – 16 who has tested positive for COVID-19 via a PCR test within the past 90 days.

Additional advice

- Any parents or carers who still want their child to continue to attend school have the right to do so. **In these situations, we strongly advise the child or young person identified as a sibling close contact to get a PCR test before attending school.**
- Anyone who develops symptoms of COVID-19 should get a PCR test and stay at home until the result is known. Individuals informed by Test & Trace to isolate should stay at home for the time advised.
