Parking in the Village

At the start and end of the school day, the traffic in the village can be very busy and congested. There is a voluntary 'one way system' through the village at these times—coming down the village from Town Head and out towards the road to Warwick Bridge. Also, please be aware of local residents when parking . Please do not park in front of their access ways, garages etc. and please do not park on the double yellow lines. Lunchtimes

We have started the new year with an updated lunchtime routine for the children. As you know, we have to feed our children in two sittings as the hall is not large enough to accommodate all our children at once. This year, having reinstated and refreshed our 'Buddy' system, older children have been given the choice and chance to hold the responsible position of 'Buddy'. A 'buddy' helps the younger children with their lunch, chats with them about their day and is a 'big' friendly face that can be called on. 'Buddies' sit together at lunchtime to instigate talk and support the teaching of such things as manners, cutting up food, how to tidy up after yourself, talking around the lunch table and so on. Other children are sitting in 'family' tables, mixing with other children from different year groups (as well as being with some of their own friends too) - again to promote more mixing across year groups, encouraging the 'family' lunch experience.

Tables also now have 'Table Leaders' - older children who have the responsibility of tidying their tables before everyone leaves.

Each day this week we have made tweaks and changes to make this work for the children (and us) and we hope this will develop further as the year progresses.
