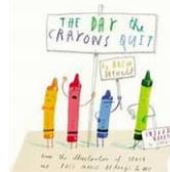


Books we will be reading:

'Jeffers' (Year 2) Learning Overview Autumn Term 2023

In our writing we will be learning and embedding:

- Correct choice and consistent use of past and present tense throughout writing
- Expanded noun phrases for description
- Subordination (using when, if, that, because)
- Co-ordination (or, and, but)
- Question, exclamation and statement
- Formation of nouns using suffixes e.g. -ness, -er
- Formation of adjectives using suffixes e.g. -ful, -less
- Use of the suffix -ly to turn adjectives into adverbs
- Full stop, capital letter, exclamation mark, question mark

Our spellings will come home each week and will also be set on 'Spelling Shed':

- Revision of 'ai', 'ee', 'igh', 'oa', 'oo'
- /j/ spelled 'g', 'ge', 'dge'
- /n/ spelled 'kn' and 'gn'
- /r/ spelled 'wr'
- /ee/ spelled 'ey'
- /s/ spelled 'c'
- Common Words
- /il/ spelled 'il'

In our Maths we will be learning and embedding:

- Place Value**
 - Recognise tens and ones
 - Partition numbers to 100
 - Write numbers to 100 in words
 - 10s and 1s on the number line to 100
- Addition and subtraction**
 - Fact families – addition and subtraction bonds within 20
 - Add and subtract 1s
 - Subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number
- Shape**
 - 2-D shapes
 - 3-D shapes
 - Lines of symmetry

We will also have tasks set on 'Mathletics' and 'TTRS'
