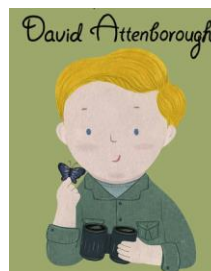

We will be writing:

- Biography

In our writing we will be learning and embedding the use of:

- Noun phrases, expanded by the addition of modifying adjectives, nouns and prepositions
- Fronted adverbials
- Nouns or pronouns to aid cohesion and avoid repetition
- Paragraphs to organise ideas around the theme
- Apostrophes for possession
- Use commas after fronted adverbials
