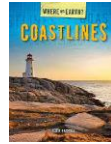
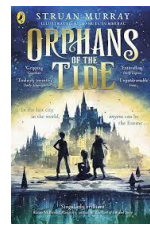
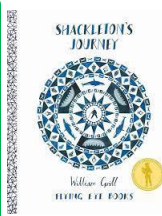

'Pankhurst' (Year 5/6) Learning Overview Autumn Term 2023

We will be writing:

- Flashback Narrative
- Newspaper Article
- Endurance Narrative
- Biography

In our writing we will be learning and embedding:

- Words related by meaning; synonyms and antonyms.
- Converting nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes.
- Using expanded noun phrases to convey complicated information concisely.
- Understanding the difference between structures typical of informal speech and structures appropriate to formal.
- Use headings, sub-headings, columns and captions to organize information.
- Semi-colons to mark a boundary between independent clauses.
- Using hyphens to avoid ambiguity.
- Using the range of punctuation taught at KS2.

- Multiplication and Division A

Year 6:
