A flexible payment system is available. **This applies to EVERYONE in Nursery through to Year 6 including those who do not have to pay for their meals or who have not previously had to order on School Gateway.**

A Few Important Reminders

School Hours and Parking

School opens at 8.30am and children should be in their classrooms by 8.50am latest for class registration. Registers close at 8.55am and school assembly starts promptly at 9am. Any parents having to drop off their children before 8.30am will need to book them into Breakfast Club in order to ensure adequate child care cover. Please could we ask all parents to park sensitively in the village, not to block junctions, driveways or garages, not to drive up to the top of the school hill to pick up children and to adhere to the voluntary one way system, driving into Hayton from the Lane End Inn road or from Hayton Townhead. **This is in the interests of the safety of everybody.**

With regard to the single yellow lines, the regulations are that no-one should park on these lines between the hours of 8am and 4pm, Monday to Friday.

Morning Routine

Parents of children in Y1-Y6 are asked to leave their children at the main school door in the morning to make their own way into their classrooms. This helps to keep the corridors clear and allows the teachers to get on with organising their day. Teachers can be contacted by e-mail (addresses can be found on our school website: www.hayton.cumbria.sch.uk/contact.html) or are happy to meet with parents at a pre-arranged time.

End of School Routine

- Children are not permitted to leave school premises i.e. outside of the school gate, unless a parent/carer is present.
- Written permission will be needed for older children to walk unaccompanied home, to cars parked further away from the school or to the playground.
- To alleviate crowding and confusion, we would ask those collecting children in Years 3-6 to stand outside the school gate. **However, Early Years (Reception and Nursery) can be collected at the Hall entrance and Year 1 and Year 2 can be collected from the Year 1 outdoor side entrance.**
- KS1 children (Years 1 and 2) who have older siblings and who are not collected at 3.15pm, will remain with supervision in their classroom until 3.30pm.
- Children who have not been collected on time will be taken to After School Club (please be aware there may be a charge for this).
- Teacher led after school clubs: Parents can pick children up from the front door at club finish time.

School Clothing

A reminder to label ALL your children's clothing and to send children in with suitable outdoor clothing for break times (waterproof coats, hats, gloves etc.).
